

Q: What are service learning courses and what are the types and differences?

A :

1. The school's service learning courses include service learning (1), service learning (2), service learning (3), and "general or professional courses integrated into the meaning of service learning". Except for the credits of the original curriculum plan, the remaining service learning (1), (2), (3) courses are compulsory 0 credits, as described below:

service learning (1)	Based on the principle of maintaining the cleanliness of the school's public space environment, let students learn the spirit of service and cultivate an attitude of caring for the environment.	* 0 credits required, but less than 18 hours per semester is prohibited. service learning (2)	Based on the principle of having service content inside and outside the school, it can also be engaged in cleaning and maintenance of public spaces.	* 0 credits required, but less than 18 hours per semester is prohibited. service learning (3)	The principle is to integrate professional services of the department. You can also go to out-of-school community service or humanistic care for the disadvantaged, non-	* 0 credits required, but less than 18 hours per semester is prohibited. The minimum actual service hours per course is 8 hours. ◦ * If you take more than 2 service learning (3) courses, you must obtain the approval of the department head before taking the service learning (2)	Departments or administrative units

types	contents	Course requirements	Units of Curriculum
	profit organization group services, or tutoring in elementary and junior high schools in various countries, or integrate with the student community of this school, or take service learning courses offered by the administrative unit in the school.	courses. * freshman year, sophomore year, junior year or senior year °	
general or professional courses integrated into the meaning of service learning	Professional or general courses offered by departments and general education centers.	* In addition to the original teaching hours, an actual service of at least 8 hours must be performed. * Passing students can apply for exemption from service study (2) or service study (3) with the consent of the department head.	Departments, research institutes and general education centers

2. Students can choose courses in the school's "online course selection system". Although service learning (1), (2), and (3) are based on the principle of electing service learning courses planned by the department, they can also choose other courses with the consent of the department head. Courses run by administrative units or associations. In addition to service learning (3), in addition to being offered by the department, administrative units can also provide such courses. The starting code is "(A6) Service Learning SS". Such service learning (3) courses are open to whole school students.
